Additional Program Requirements

Depending on the customer's network security settings, certain ports may need to be opened for the connectivity from the client device (a computer or mobile device) to the server.

EPS Programs require use of the following ports:

- 80 for Apache Web Server
- 4900 for the database
- 4910 for JBoss
- 5910 and 5911 for *Portfolio for Academy of READING*

Accessing EPS Online Programs from Home

EPS online programs are Web-based and can be accessed through your computer's Web browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome) at home.

A home connection must provide a consistent bandwidth speed of 500 Kbps or greater. This is within the range of most Internet service providers' high-speed connection offerings. Consider that other factors (e.g. streaming audio and video or security updates) can affect download speeds. For issues with a slow internet connect, contact your internet service provider for assistance.

Web Content Filtering Software

For home access, if you are using security or Web content filtering software, it is possible that some content (such as audio files) may be blocked. As with pop-up blocking, you can either disable these filters or create an exception for the epsbooks.com website.
